Field Session

Participants and Instructor will agree on a date and location for a field session to view the night sky through binoculars and telescopes. The Instructor will provide a large telescope and some binoculars. Participants will be encouraged to bring their own binoculars and telescopes if they have them (ownership of optical instruments is not a course requirement).

There is no required reading for this class, no syllabus, and no homework. Each participant is encouraged to bring a note pad and pen for notes. Participants will be able to download the slide deck from each week's session (after each session is complete—not before).
