Paint Surface:

- 12 x 12 canvas, panel, or paper
- Paper, canvas, panel, or notebook to use to paint color swatches on

Paint:

- Cobalt Blue
- Naphthol Red
- Hansa Yellow or Cadmium Lemon Yellow
- White
- Black
- Plus any other paint colors you have

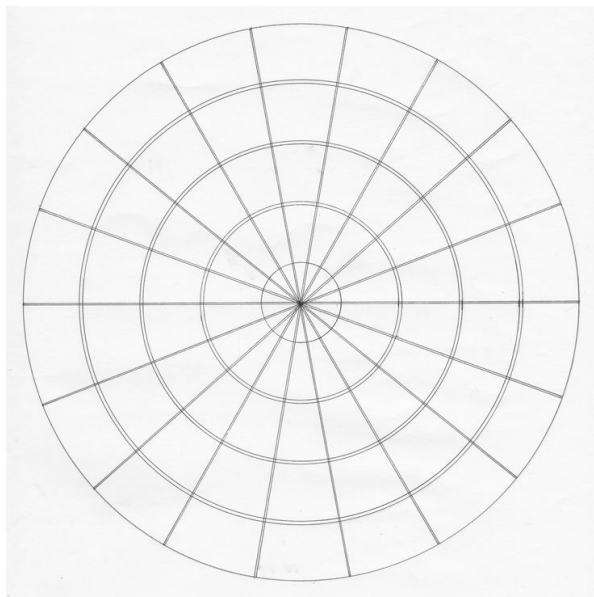
Brushes:

- 2-3 flat brushes around sizes 8 - 12

Other:

- Pick up 3 or 4 of color chip cards (the ones that have multiple colors on them) from the paint department of your local paint or hardware store. We'll use those for the color matching exercise.
- Odorless mineral spirits or turpenoid. I like Gamblins Gamsol.
- Rags
- Paper towels
- Palette
- Something to take notes on
- A palette knife

Directions: Before class please enlarge the color wheel below to fit your 12 x 12 canvas and draw it on your canvas, paper, or panel. Leave enough room to allow you to label colors around the outside edge of the wheel.



For this class, you can use acrylic, oil, or watercolor. Dick Blick in Sugar House carries good student grade paint for the money.
