## **Materials List**

Students supply their own rods, equipment, and flies OR Students may rent equipment from the instructor at additional cost

## For Saturday's river session:

Students need to have weather-appropriate clothing, and a complete change of clothes. Sun protection and quick-drying are themes students should use when considering clothing.

Your instructor wears: thick wool socks, shin guards, knee pads, quick dry pants (or thermal pants), long sleeve or hooded sunshirt, brimmed hat, polarized glasses.

If the weather is cold/rainy students need a rain jacket and an insulating jacket. Wading boots and waders are required for spring and fall semesters, optional for summer.

Boots and waders can be rented at Western Rivers Flyfisher. Western Rivers also rents full rod and reel setups suitable for beginning fly fishing.
