**Oil Paints: 1.25 oz. small tubes:** I prefer Gamblin, but other good brands include Utrecht, Winsor & Newton, Old Holland

- Titanium White
- Ivory Black
- Cadmium Yellow Light or Lemon Yellow
- Yellow Ochre (optional)
- Cadmium Yellow Medium
- Cadmium Red Light
- Alizarin Crimson
- Transparent Oxide Red
- Ultramarine Blue
- Viridian Green

### Brushes and tools:

- Disposable palette or glass palette
- 2" razor blade (optional)
- \*Palette covering (optional but convenient)
- Metal palette knife medium sized
- Oil brush set or variety of 3-4 oil brushes sizes 4-12 flats and filberts, and one round detail brush synthetic (I like Robert Simmons or Silver grand prix available online at Jerry's Artarama or Dick Blick online)
- Gamsol odorless mineral spirits 16oz or larger **NO TURPENTINE**
- Silicoil brush cleaning tank or metal turpentine cup to hold gamsol

### Extras:

- 1 bar of soap or small bottle of dawn
- Case to hold brushes (optional)
- Case to hold paint (optional)
- Paper towels or old rags
- Apron or old Shirt (optional)
- Gloves or invisible glove cream (optional)
- Case for wet paintings (optional but makes it easier when transporting work)

- Sketchbook or unlined paper, pencil, eraser for sketching
